What's Happening in the Main Workshop?

The main workshop is buzzing with activity 7 days a week. In order to prepare them for the boat building industry, the 40 week students learn by building several boats from start to finish in the second half of the course.

11 of our students started in February 2020 and have endured several lockdowns – they have been incredibly patient however and are nearing the end of their course. In October last year they teamed up with 7 more students and are building 6 interesting and demanding boats.

The boats:

12' Gartside sailing dinghy: cold-moulded from western red cedar

14'6" Vivier Ilur: glued clinker

10' Morgan Giles launch - 1.5hp Stuart Turner: carvel - khaya mahogany on oak

16'6" Gorran Haven spritsail yawl: carvel - larch on oak

14' Gartside Skylark: trad clinker - khaya mahogany

21'3" Utility launch – 15hp diesel inboard: strip plank – yellow cedar

The boats are already looking fantastic and it promises to be a wonderful day.

The majority of the group are planning to work as boat builders after the course and have already lined up trials with fantastic boat builders.
