## Military Families Affected by Suicide

SSAFA, the Armed Forces charity provide bereavement support groups for families who have lost a loved one in the Armed Forces. Our Military Families Affected by Suicide support group began in 2019 when we appreciated there was a need, for those families who had lost loved ones to suicide.

We currently provide ongoing support to 85 families and last month 14 people attended our residential weekend in the Lake District. The aim of the weekend was to bring together those who have experienced similar loss, offering a safe, therapeutic environment to foster peer support and meaningful connection.

Our Military Families Affected by Suicide group facilitates peer-to-peer support and provides a safe space for the military bereaved community to grieve for lost loved ones, giving an opportunity for respite and to build connections with those facing similar lived experiences.

We also support the bereaved family member, helping them to learn about the grieving process and gain useful strategies and tools to enhance their wellbeing, facilitated in a safe environment.
